

What is an adult guardianship system?



An **adult guardianship system** is a system that legally supports individuals whose capacity for judgment is limited due to dementia, impaired intelligence, and/or mental disorder.

There are following types of guardianships:

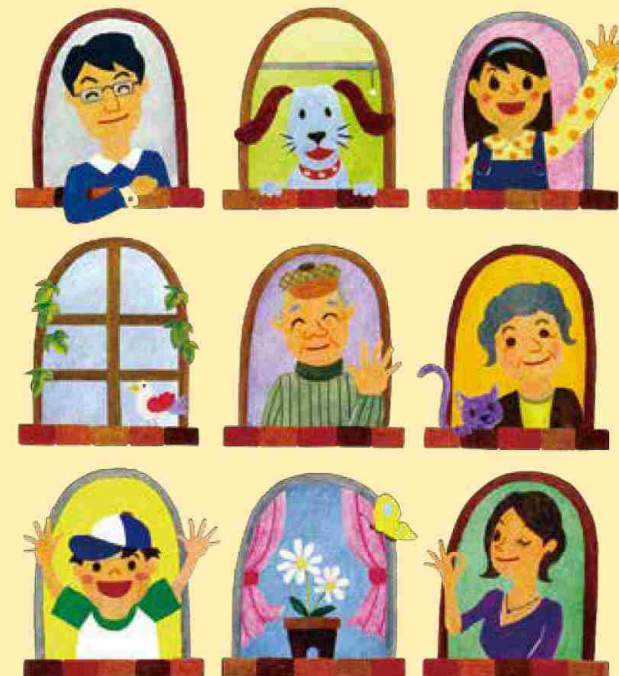
Category	Individual's capacity for judgment	Supporter	
Assistance	Not sufficient	Assistant	A supervisor may be appointed.
Curatorship	Significantly lacking	Curator	
Guardianship	Lacking in normal state	Guardian of adult	
Voluntary guardianship	In this system, when an individual's capacity for judgment becomes insufficient, the voluntary guardian supports the individual based on the voluntary guardianship contract entered into by the individual and the voluntary guardian beforehand. The agreement takes effect when the family court appoints the supervisor for the voluntary guardian .		

* As supporter, **multiple people** or a **corporation** may be appointed as necessary.

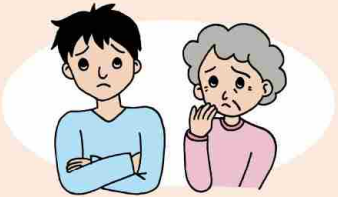

Flow of Process

If someone who does not have sufficient capacity for judgment wants to

- Sell a house,
- Receive welfare services, or
- Divide an estate, etc.

he or she may be concerned about doing it by themselves or cannot do it by themselves.



Petition

- **Petition for starting assistance, curatorship, and guardianship**



[Documents to be submitted when filing the petition]

- Petition form
- Medical certificate (for adult guardianship)
- Petition service charge (revenue stamps worth 800 yen for each case)
- Registration fee (revenue stamps worth 2,600 yen)
- Postage stamps
- Copy of family register of individual, etc.

For more information, please check the list provided at the family court.

- **Petition for appointment of supervisor for voluntary guardian**

* Once a petition is filed, the petition cannot be withdrawn without the permission of the court.

Contract is made by notarial deed.

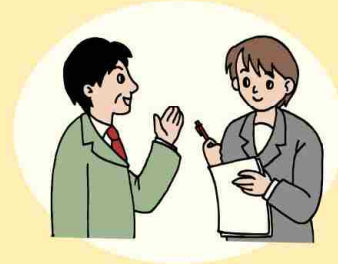

Investigation, etc.

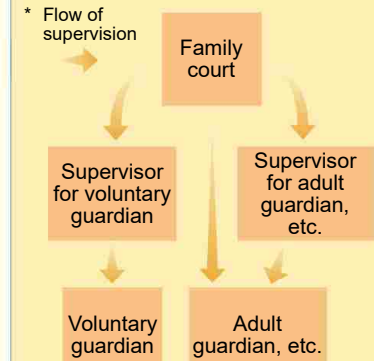
- ★ The court may ask about the circumstances.
